Mechanical ejectors	Cyanide version used in USA for 40 years. 1080, cyanide and PAPP versions likely. High target specificity and good field longevity.	1080 - now others - 2013	
Lethal Trap Device (LTD; green tube)	Contains cyanide- rapidly euthanizes trapped dogs and foxes, improving animal welfare and reducing labour requirements. Export potential.	under development
